



Partnering for Health & Wellness

Circleville City Schools has teamed up with Berger Health System to provide convenient and affordable healthcare through the Berger Tiger Care Clinic located in the Circleville Elementary School building.

Who can be seen at the Clinic? All students attending Circleville City Schools, as well as staff members.

Do I need to complete anything before my child can be seen at the Clinic? All required forms must be completed and returned prior to seeing your child in the Clinic.

Where do I get the forms I need to complete? All required Clinic forms are available on the Circleville City School website. Printed copies are included in the start of the year school forms this year and are also available in the school offices. Completed forms can be returned to the school office.

Can I complete the forms in advance, in case my child gets sick at school and needs to be seen? Absolutely! All forms may be completed in advance regardless of whether or not your child is currently ill. Completed forms are good for the duration of the school year. However, keep in mind if there are any medical changes which may influence your child's care such as; new medications, new medical diagnosis, change in preferred pharmacy, or allergies to medications, you will need to send in updated information.

Do I have to make an appointment? No, all visits are seen on a first come, first serve basis.

Are parents required to be present for a student to be seen in the Clinic? Although we encourage a parent/guardian presence, it is not a requirement. If you are unable to attend please notify the school that you would like your child seen that day via a phone call or written note stating what symptoms they are experiencing.

How much will it cost if my student is seen? All visits are billed directly through your students insurance. No money will be collected at the time of the visit. Visit costs vary slightly based on the complexity of the visit. We do our best to keep costs of visits and prescribed medications low.

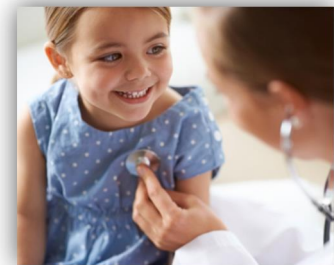
How will I learn my student's diagnosis? The Clinic team will call and update you at the contact number you provided us, letting you know the diagnosis and recommended care. If we are unable to reach you, we will leave a message for you to return a call to us. A clinic note will also be sent home with students after each visit, updating you of their visit.

What if my student is prescribed a prescription medication? All prescriptions will be sent directly to the pharmacy you have indicated on your form the same day of the Clinic visit.

- Ear Pain
- Flu Symptoms

- Urinary Tract Infection
