Calamity Day Plan for 2018-19 – Calendar

The official school calendar for the 2018-19 school year includes 178 days of instruction for students, two (2) Parent-Teacher Conference Days, and four (4) Staff/Professional Development Days, for a total of 184 days. Teachers new to the district will also be required to attend one (1) additional day of In-Service prior to the Opening Convocation, on Thursday, August 9th, 2018. Additionally, the CEA has agreed to an hours-based recording system whereas, students in grades K-6 must attend a minimum of 910 hours of instruction and students in grades 7-12 must attend a minimum of 1,001 hours of instruction.

Therefore, we will follow the calamity make-up day schedule below:

1. **Students** will be permitted eight (8) days of missed school without any make-up due to weather or other conditions that may cancel school. On calamity day nine (9) the district will make plans to make-up the necessary hours on the schedule as outlined below.
2. **Staff** will be permitted three (3) days of missed work without any make-up due to weather or other conditions that may cancel school. On calamity day four (4), and beyond, staff will report to work unless the county in which you reside, or Pickaway County, is on a Level 2 or Level 3 Snow Emergency. All district teaching and classified staff will report by 10:00 am and work until 3:00 pm. **Exception: Custodial and Maintenance Staff will work a 5-hour shift (on all days) as determined by the Maintenance Supervisor.**
3. The district will begin scheduling make-up days on day nine (9) and beyond.
4. Make-up days will be as follows:
 - a. Make-up Day 1- April 18th, 2019
 - b. Make-up Day 2- April 22nd, 2019
 - c. Make-up Day 3- May 10th, 2019
 - d. Make-up Day 4- May 17th, 2019
 - e. Any further make-up days will begin on Tuesday, May 28, 2019 and continue until all days/hours have been made up.

*Note- Circleville City Schools will not use blizzard bags in the 2018-2019 school year.
