Our District Leadership Team along with the Board of Education has spent the past month reviewing, analyzing and modifying our school district's safety plan. Beginning on Tuesday, February 19th, we will institute several new procedures:

All entrances to the elementary schools will be locked at 9:00 am

All tardy students and visitors to all of our elementary schools will be required to ring the doorbell for admittance

All visitors, including parents and guardians, will be required to show proper identification for admission to be granted. ***Please bring a picture ID to the school to gain admittance.***

At CHS, all doors except one main entrance door will be locked at 7:30 am.

Visitors will be directed to the Main Office upon arrival. Visitors and tardy students will not be able to enter any student hallways without first being registered in the Main Office.

At EMS, all doors except the main entrance door on Court Street will be locked at 7:30 am. Visitors will be directed to the Main Office upon arrival. Visitors and tardy students will not be able to enter any student hallways without first being registered in the Main Office.

Cameras have been installed at the main entrances to all buildings and will be monitored throughout the day by school personnel.

Please remember that we are instituting these new procedures for the safety of our students and staff. We are committed to providing a safe learning environment for the students of the Circleville City Schools. Next week, I will provide you with a summary of the additional safety equipment and new technology that will be included in our new schools currently under construction.
