We have started the abatement process for the eventual demolition of the current Circleville High School. In an effort to stay on schedule for the entire project, we permitted our construction manager to schedule the abatement of floor and ceiling tiles at CHS. I am sure you may remember the Kroger's renovation this past year when they removed floor tile and kept the polished concrete as the flooring. We are doing the same thing at CHS. This two month project will allow us to immediately begin the CHS demolition project when we vacate the building next January. By doing so, we will remain on schedule for the construction of the new middle school scheduled to begin next June. We are limiting access to CHS until August 5th due to this abatement work. I would ask that you please call the CHS office, 474-4846 prior to showing up at the building.

The city of Circleville and Darby Creek Construction will soon begin roadwork on the Clark Drive extension in front of Pickaway Manor. Clark Drive to Pickaway Manor and to our parking lots will remain open throughout the project but it may be a little congested and dusty through the summer.
